Community Discussion: Thinking Outside the Box: Utilizing Non-Traditional Resources When Advising LGBTQI+ Students

Overview:

This community discussion acknowledges the gap that exists in data and support for LGBTQI+ students in education abroad. It also explores why that is and how it can complicate our work in student advising. It also aims to flip the ways that we talk about LGBTQI+ students, and underrepresented communities at large, - from deficits or barrier model. We'll introduce some basic concepts of asset-based advising and consider what some of those skills are for our LGBTQI+ students. And more importantly, how that can inform their education abroad experience - from the beginning to the end. So, if we understand the first two points it brings us to the crux of this presentation - LGBTQI+ students and communities are constantly navigating spaces that may not be 100% accommodating for them. So, we want to explore some of those with you and get you thinking about what other resources you might be using as well.
