## DIVERSITY ABROAD MEMBERSHIP

Diversity Abroad's annual membership runs from July 1st through June 30th\*. Memberships are available at the institutional or individual level. Institutional membership provides access to resources for 2-50 professional colleagues\*\* from the same institution/organization. Individual memberships are available for graduate students and other professionals not affiliated with a member institution or organization.
