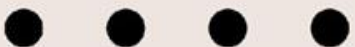

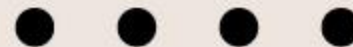

 - Second workshop: How It Started, How It's Going and Financing Your Global Education Experience

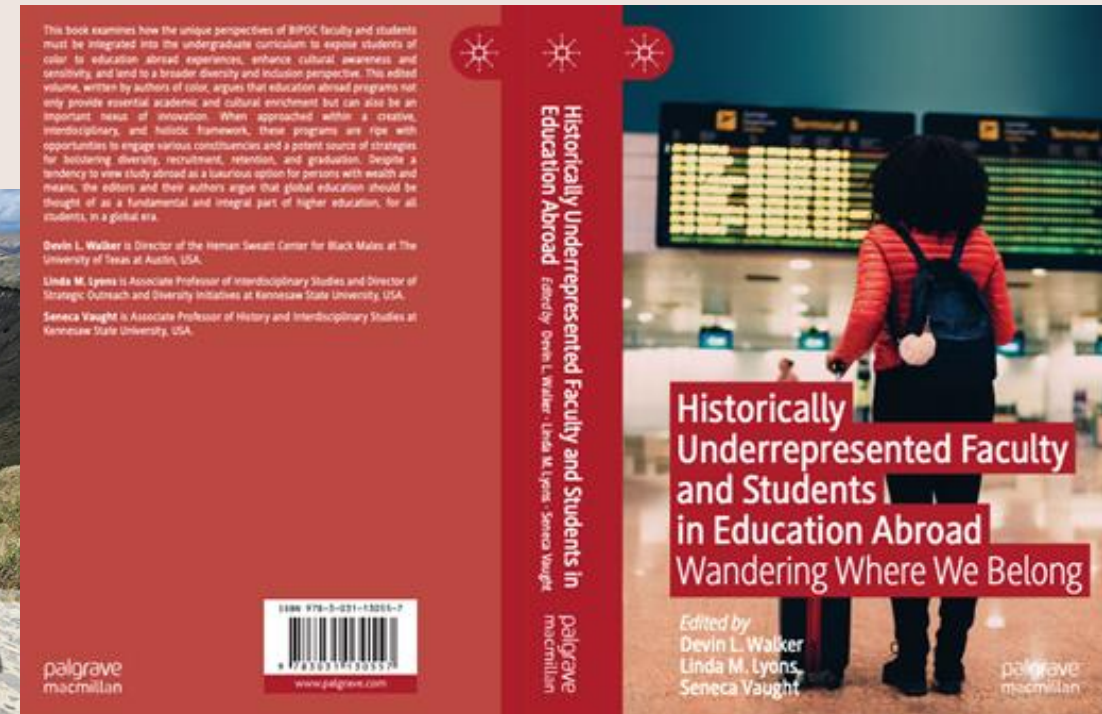
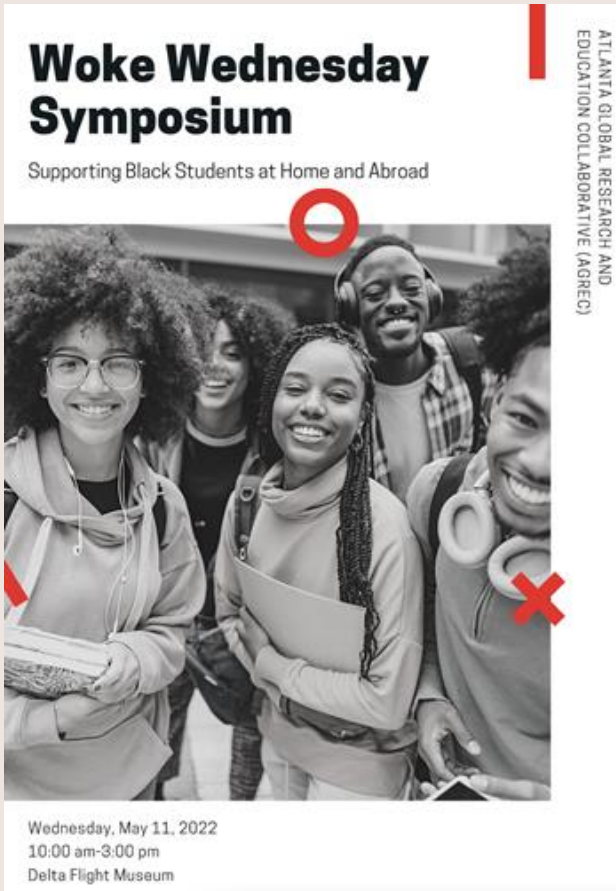


Woke Wednesday Symposium
